

Hanover's Dartmouth Printing chooses Sunday 2000

Dartmouth Printing Company is the first to install Heidelberg Sunday 2000 web presses in a duplexed configuration.

Dartmouth brought the twin four-unit presses on line in September. Fast makereadies and gapless blanket print quality were key factors in selecting the Sunday 2000, according to vice president of operations Jack Elliott. "With the digital prepress gateway and automation features, including semi-automatic plate changing, we can go from the end of one job to saleable copies on the following job in as little as 15 minutes," Elliott explains.

The new 16-page Sunday 2000 systems can operate independently or they can be duplexed to produce forms of up to 32 pages. The configuration provides versatility to meet a wide range of customer demands.
