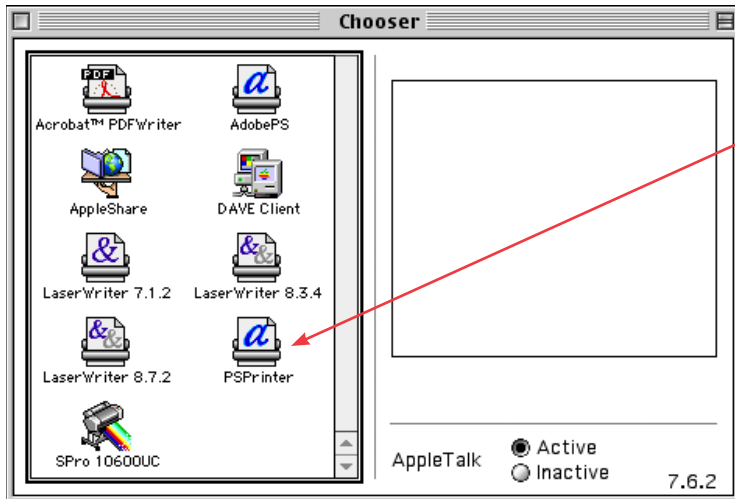
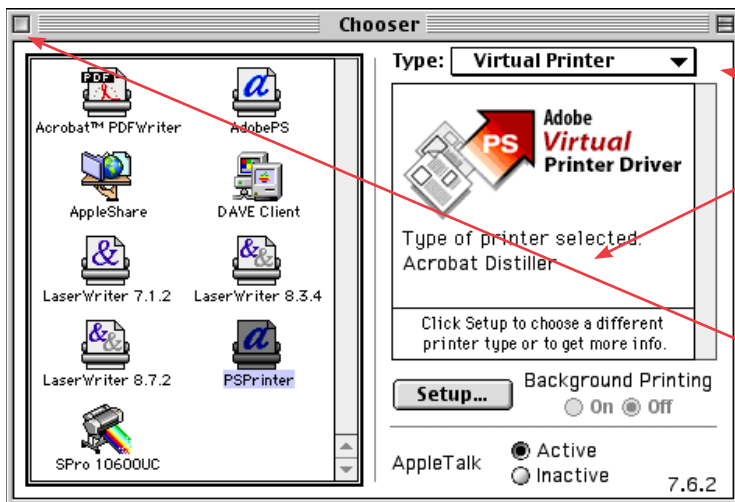


# PageMaker 7 MAC Printing PostScript



## Step 1

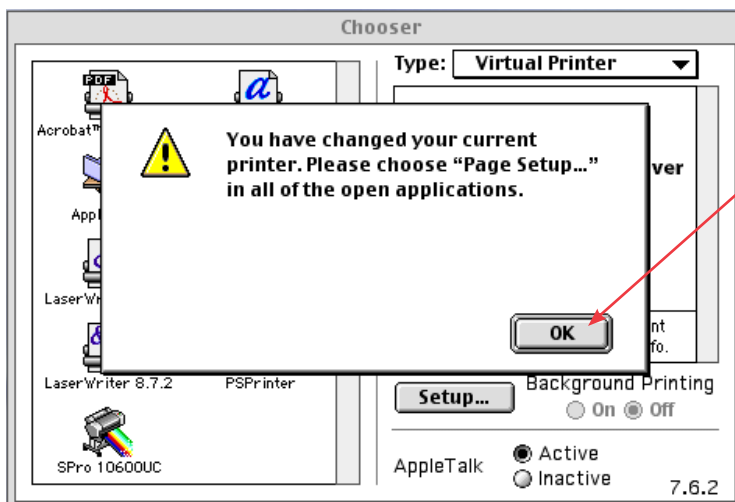
Open the Chooser and select the PSPrinter.



## Step 2

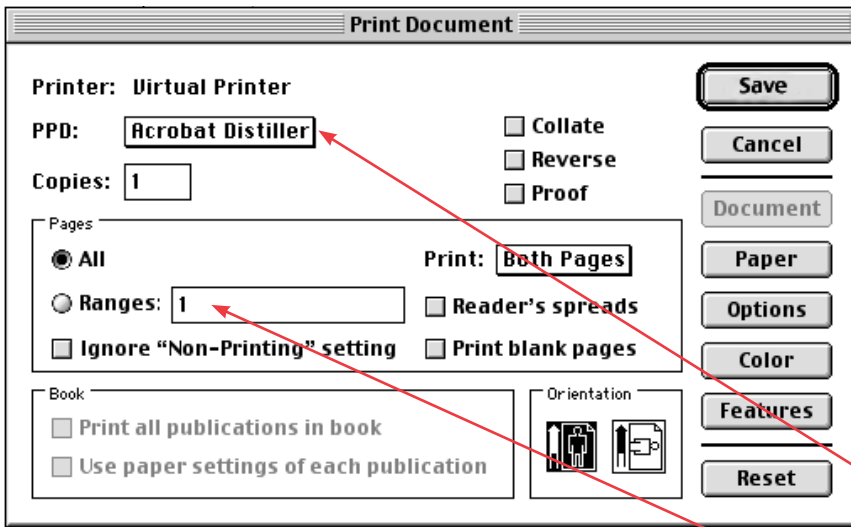
Select the Virtual Printer and the Acrobat Distiller PPD. See separate document for Virtual Printer setup.

Close window when after selecting the printer.



## Step 3

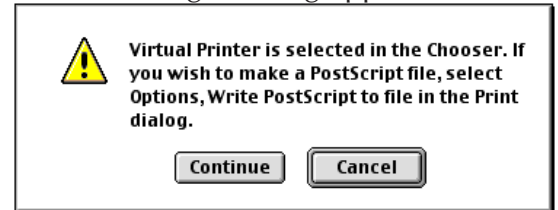
Click on "OK".



#### Step 4

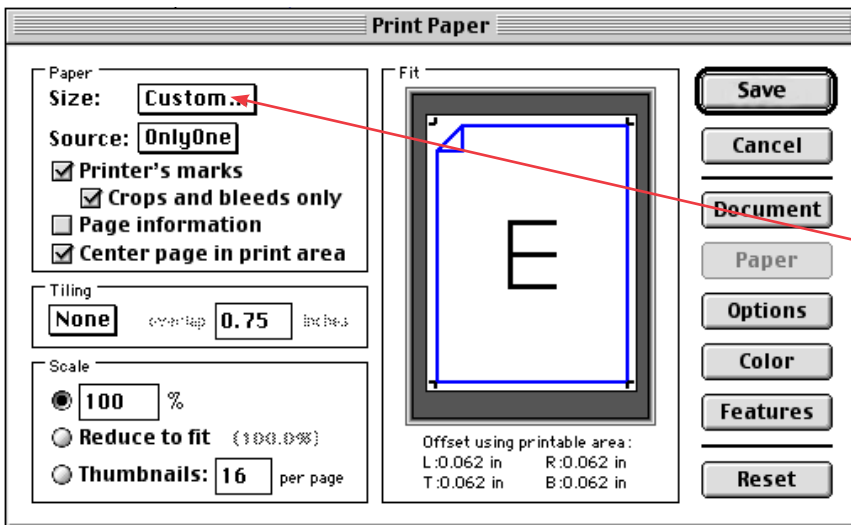
Go to "Print" under the file menu.

Click continue when the following warning appears.



Select the PostScript Printer and the Acrobat Distiller ppd.

Enter the pages you want to print.

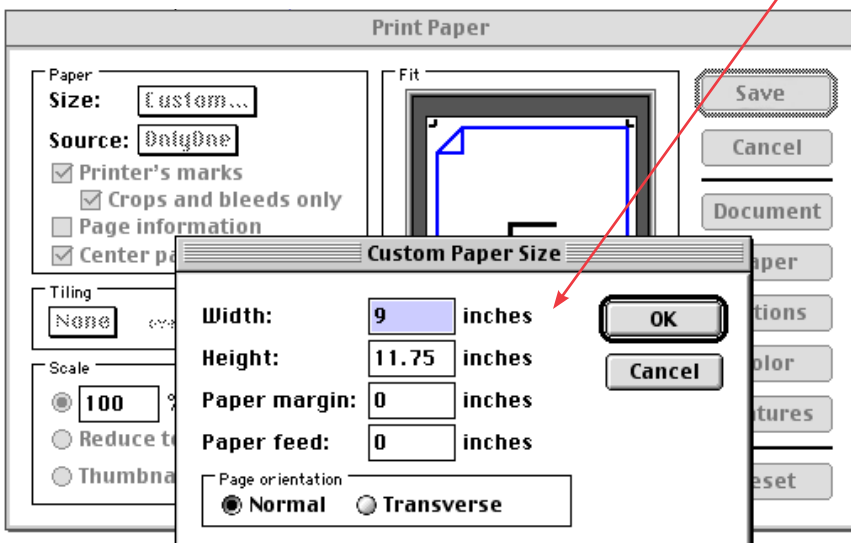


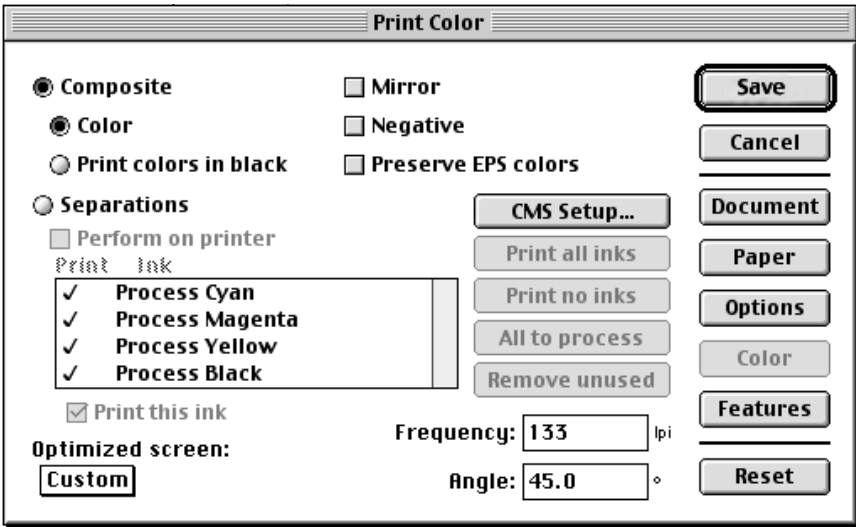
#### Step 5

After matching the screen capture, select "Custom" paper size.

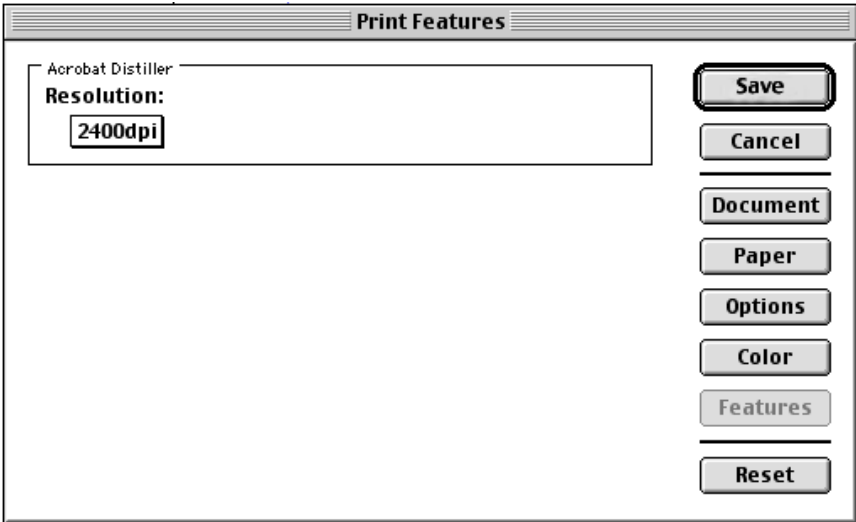
A window will pop up. The width and height should be 7/8" larger than your trim size to allow for the crop marks.

A magazine with a trim size of 8 1/8" x 10 7/8" will have a custom paper size of 9 x 11.75".

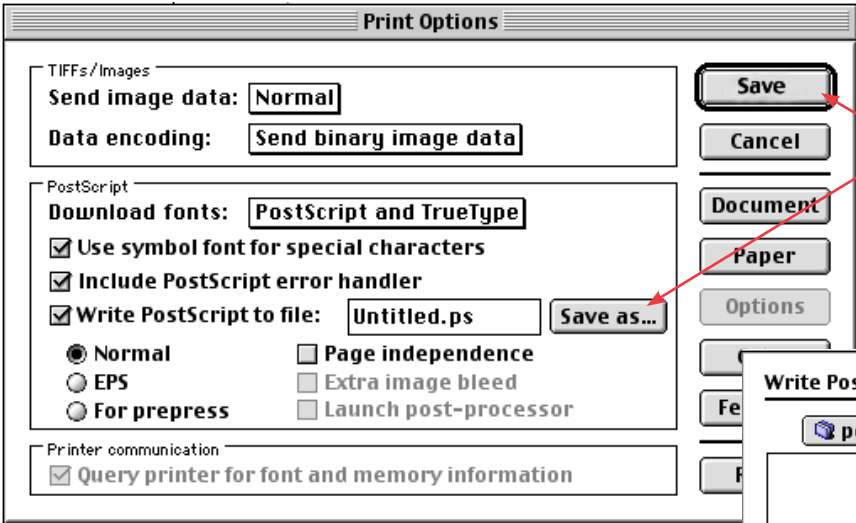




Step 6 (Skip the options tab. It will be the last setting).
