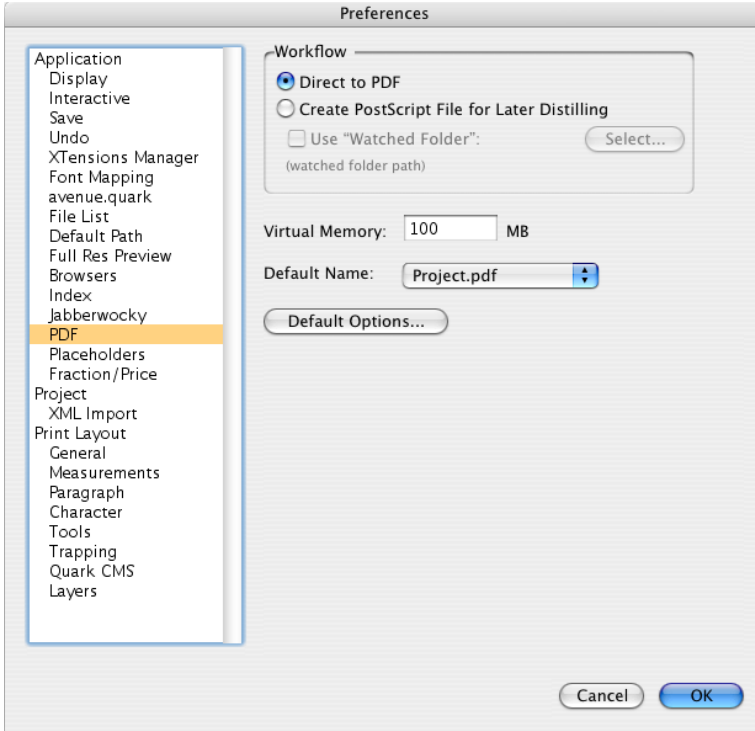

Export to PDF



Step 1

Under the “Edit” menu, select “Preferences”.

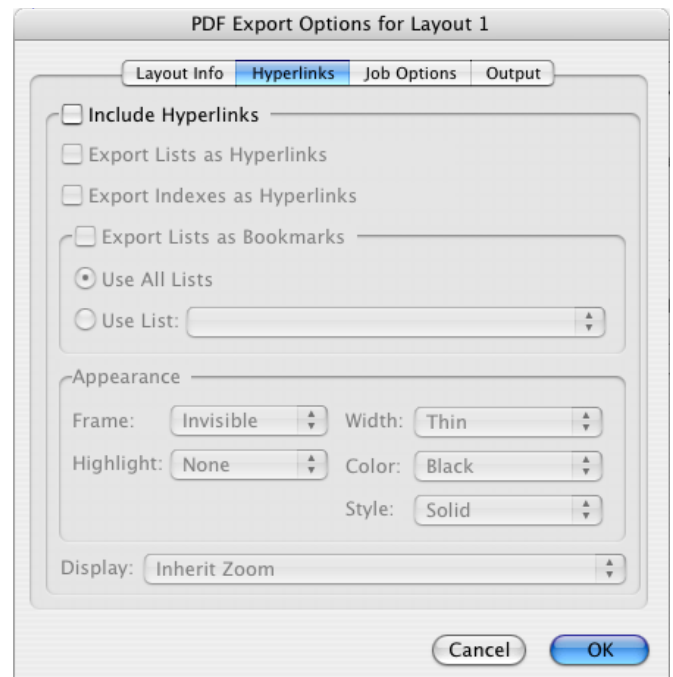
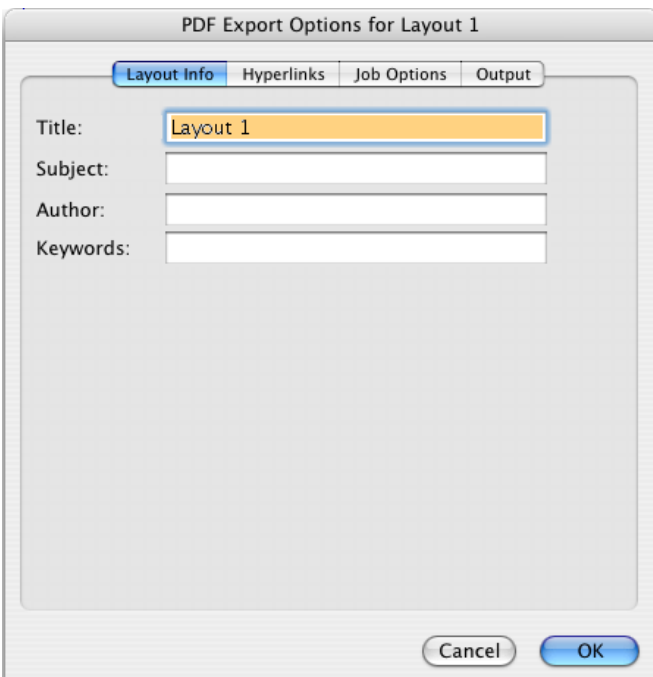
Choose PDF and make sure “Direct to PDF” is on.

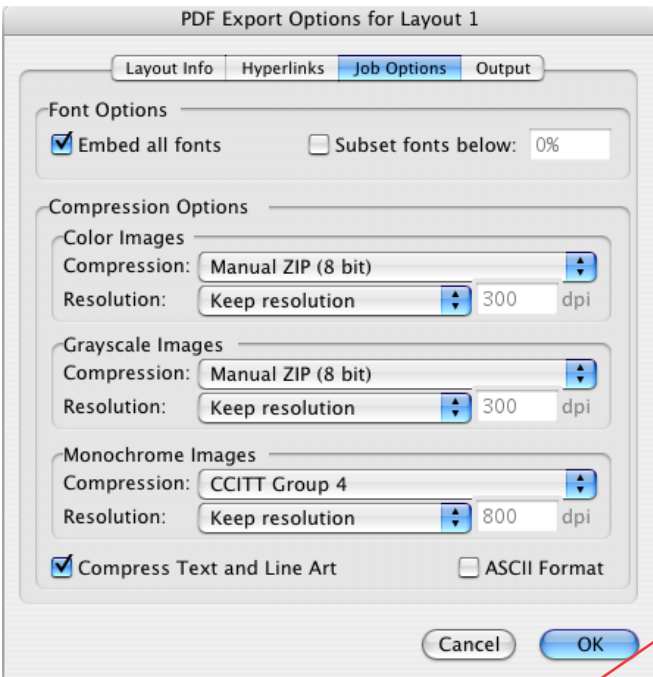
Click on options to set the default.

Note: Step 1 only needs to be done once. Step 3 will be your starting point after that.

Step 2

Match the following tabs to these settings.

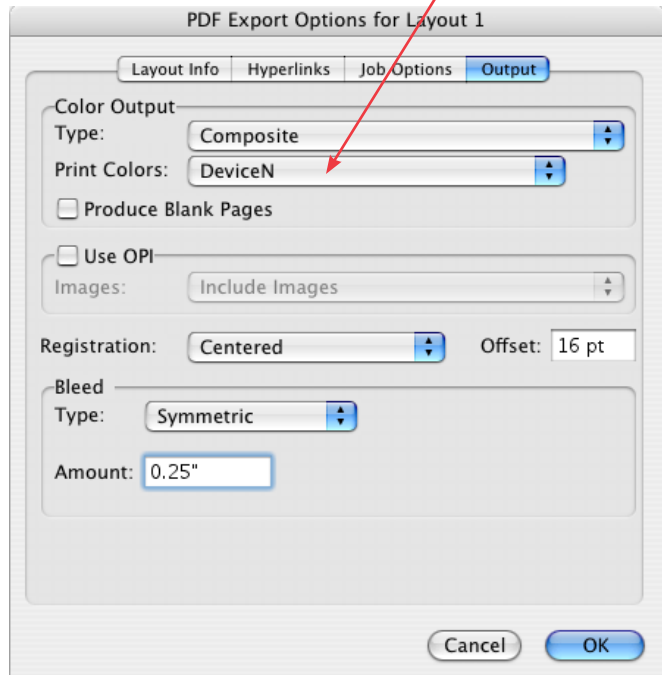
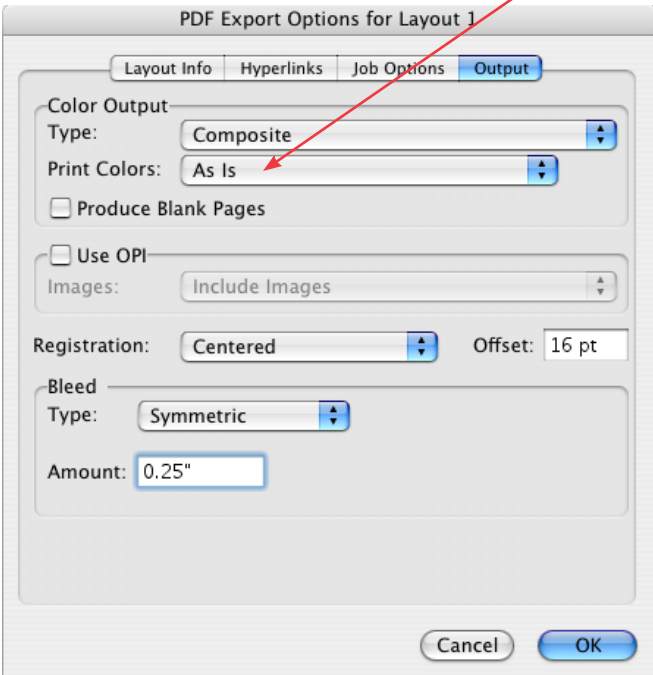


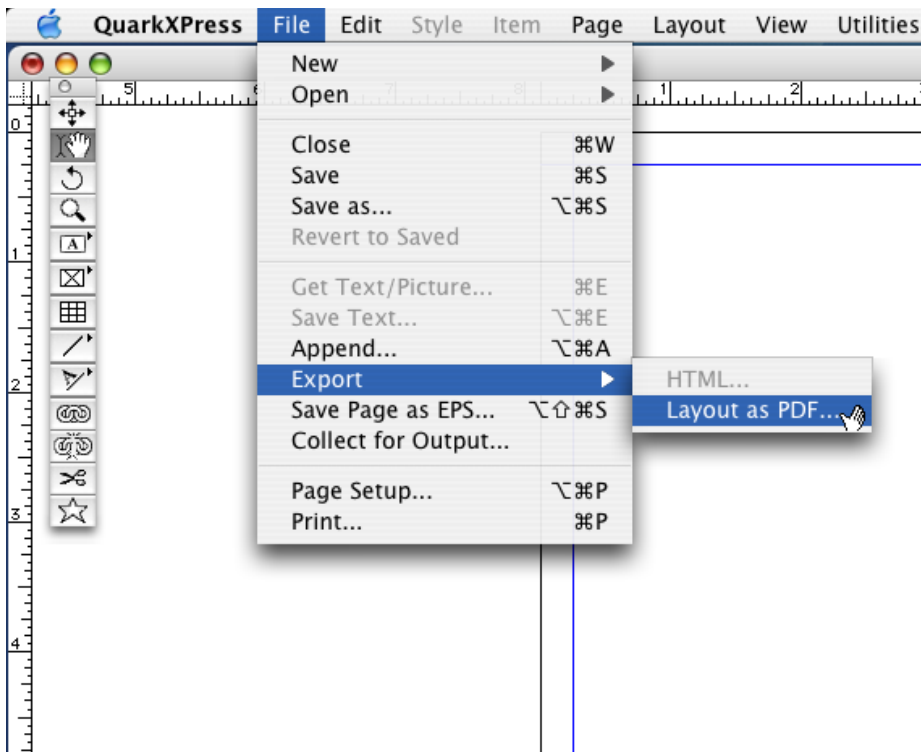


If you aren't printing with any spot colors, make sure they are converted to run from process and choose "Print Colors: As Is" in the Output tab.

If you are printing with spot colors, to make sure they process correctly, choose "Print Colors: DeviceN" in the Output tab.

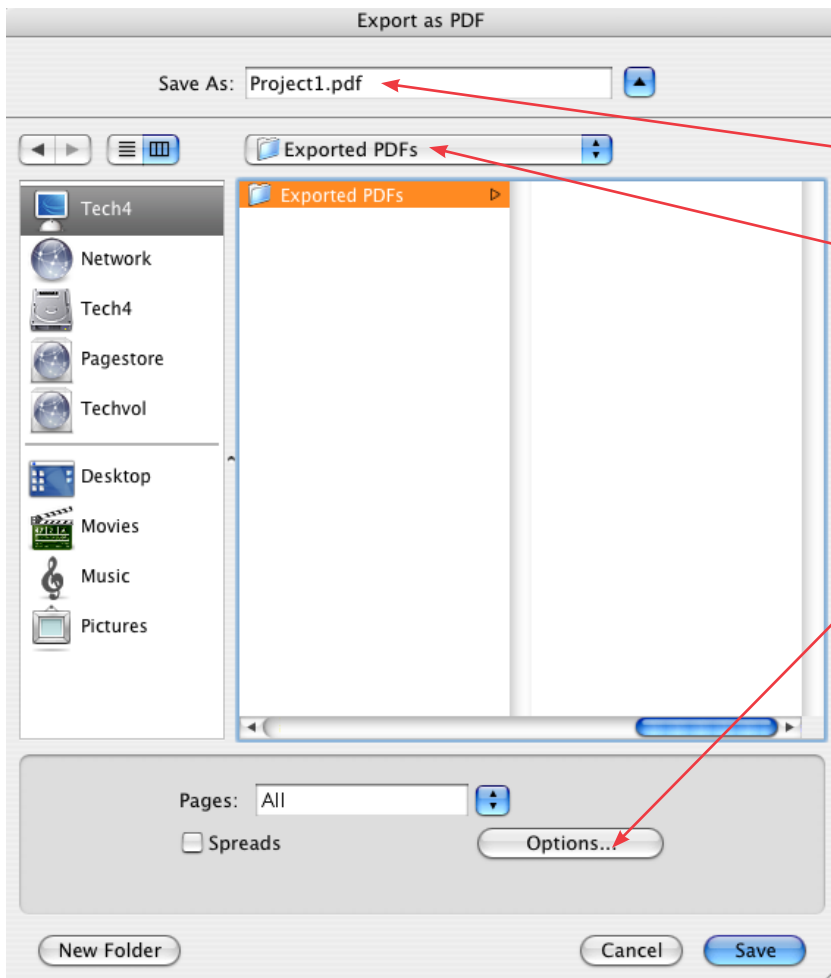
Click "OK".





Step 3

Select "Export Layout as a PDF" under the "File" menu.



Step 4

Give the file a name.

Map the folder to where you want your PDF's to go.

Then click on the "Option" button to make sure the tabs still match what you have already set for your default settings in step 2.
